Tasha D. Warlick appeals from the judgment of the trial court granting Christopher W. Warlick a full order of protection against her pursuant to the Adult Abuse Act, Sections 455.010 through 455.090 RSMo 2000. Ms. Warlick's sole claim on appeal is a challenge to the sufficiency of the evidence to support the issuance of an order of protection.

APPEAL DISMISSED.

DIVISION THREE HOLDS: This appeal is moot. The order of protection expired on June 30, 2009; the appeal was not submitted until September 17, 2009. Further, the appeal does not fall within either exception to the mootness doctrine. Thus our decision to dismiss is mandatory, rather than discretionary.
