Tammy Lalumondiere ("Mother") appeals from a judgment entered in the Circuit Court of Ste. Genevieve County dissolving her marriage to Shawn Lalumondiere ("Father") and awarding joint legal and physical custody of their minor child. Mother challenges only those portions of the judgment that relate to child custody. We affirm as modified.

AFFIRMED AS MODIFIED

Division Five Holds:

The trial court did not err in awarding the parties joint legal and physical custody of the minor child, and the parenting plans are supported by substantial evidence. Pursuant to Missouri Supreme Court Rule 84.14, we modify that section of the second parenting plan titled "Other" to read: "[t]he parties shall alternate custody on a weekly basis *during the summer non-school months* exchanging each Friday at 6:00 p.m."
