Andre Hill ("Claimant") appeals from the decision of the Labor and Industrial Relations Commission ("the Commission") denying Claimant's application for unemployment compensation benefits. Claimant contends the Commission erred in denying him unemployment benefits because the Commission's decision was not supported by competent or substantial evidence that Claimant committed misconduct.

REVERSED AND REMANDED.
