The Director of Revenue (Director) appeals from the trial court's judgment reinstating David Bouillon's (Bouillon) driving privileges after Director revoked them pursuant to Section 302.505 RSMo 2006.

REVERSED AND REMANDED.

Division Two Holds: A police officer has probable cause to arrest a driver for driving while intoxicated when the driver displays numerous indicia of intoxication and the officer receives information from the suspect and witnesses indicating that the suspect had recently driven the vehicle.

The trial court erred in ordering Director to remove the administrative revocation of Bouillon's driving privileges. We reverse and remand with directions to the trial court to reinstate Director's revocation of Bouillon's driving privileges.
