Timothy Walker appeals from the trial court's judgment and sentence after a jury found him guilty of involuntary manslaughter.

AFFIRMED

The Division Holds: Section 43.200 RSMo 2000 did not require evidence to be excluded when the St. Charles County Sheriff was not contacted before troopers from the Missouri Highway Patrol executed warrants collecting blood and urine samples from the Defendant and diagnostic information from Defendant's vehicle. Further, we find that evidence of the Defendant's demeanor toward the victim was not so prejudicial to rise to the level of plain error.
