Matthew Ahearn (Claimant) appeals from the judgment of the Labor & Industrial Relations Commission (Commission) denying him benefits. The Commission adopted the decision of the Appeals Tribunal, which affirmed a determination by the deputy of the Division of Employment Security that Claimant was discharged from his job for misconduct and therefore disqualified for unemployment benefits.

REVERSED AND REMANDED

Division Four Holds: The Commission failed to make sufficient findings of fact and conclusions of law for this Court to review whether the record supported the decision that Claimant committed misconduct connected with work.
