Defendant property owners appeal from a contempt judgment entered against them in favor of plaintiff city. The judgment imposed a \$100.00 per day fine until defendants demolished certain buildings on their property, and if defendants did not demolish the buildings by November 30, 2009, it gave the city authority to demolish the buildings after thirty days.

DISMISSED.

Division Two Holds:

Purported contempt judgment was not final for purposes of appeal because it was conditional upon the occurrence or nonoccurrence of a future act, the performance or nonperformance of which was outside the record.
