Shelley Tate appeals from the judgment of the trial court granting summary judgment to One Beacon Insurance Company (One Beacon) in her action for Declaratory Judgment and Equitable Garnishment against One Beacon seeking satisfaction of judgment against its insured, Bald Eagle Company, stemming from her personal-injury lawsuit.

AFFIRMED

Division Five Holds: The trial court did not err in granting summary judgment to One Beacon. One Beacon is entitled to judgment as a matter of law based on facts about which there is no genuine issue of material fact. ITT Commercial Fin. Corp. v. Mid-Am. Marine Supply Corp., 854 S.W.2d 371, 376 (Mo. banc 1993).
