OPINION SUMMARY

Sandra Himes (“Appellant”) appeals from her judgment of conviction in the St. Louis County Circuit Court, Municipal Division, for violating Section 607.140¹ of St. Louis County Revised Ordinances. The trial court found that Appellant failed to assure that an agreement was in effect with a waste collection service for the collection of waste generated at her home. Appellant claims the trial court erred in finding her in violation of Section 607.140 because she had an agreement in effect with General Gasket Corporation (“GGC”). The agreement with GGC allowed Appellant to dispose of waste generated at her home by taking it to GGC, which had an agreement with a waste collection service. Appellant also claims the trial court erred in not finding that she complied with Section 607.140 by complying with Section 607.100 and Section 607.120. We affirm.

AFFIRMED

DIVISION FOUR HOLDS: (1) Appellant did not have an agreement in effect with a waste collection service for the collection of waste generated at her home, and (2) Appellant did not comply with Section 607.140 by complying with Section 607.100 and/or Section 607.120.
