Lindell Briscoe (Briscoe) appeals from the motion court's denial of his Rule 29.15 amended motion for post-conviction relief after an evidentiary hearing.

Division Four holds: The motion court did not clearly err in denying Briscoe's amended motion for post-conviction relief because Briscoe failed to demonstrate by a preponderance of the evidence that his trial counsel was ineffective for failing to call two alibi witnesses at Briscoe's trial.
