The Director of Revenue for the State of Missouri appeals a judgment reinstating Alvin Mayfield's driving privileges under Section 302.060.1(9) RSMo Supp. 2009.

JUDGEMENT REVERSED, CAUSE REMANDED WITH INSTRUCTIONS.

Division Five holds: Unlawful use of drug paraphernalia, Section 195.233 RSMo 2000, is an offense related to controlled substances or drugs for purposes of determining whether to reinstate a person's driver's license under Section 302.060.1(9). Because Mayfield was convicted of unlawful use of drug paraphernalia during the preceding ten years, he is ineligible for reinstatement of his driving privileges under Section 302.060.1(9).
