Amos Ingram (Ingram) appeals from a sentence and judgment of conviction for drug trafficking in the second degree, possession of a controlled substance, unlawful possession of a firearm, and unlawful possession of drug paraphernalia.

REVERSED.

Division Five Holds: The trial court erred in denying Ingram’s motions to suppress evidence and statements, because the State failed to present sufficient evidence to demonstrate that the search warrant was supported by probable cause. We reverse and remand for further proceedings.
