Quality Heating & Air Conditioning, Inc. appeals the judgment of the Labor and Industrial Relations Commission. The Commission granted unemployment benefits to Chad Kraemer, determining that he was discharged for reasons other than misconduct.

AFFIRMED.

DIVISION ONE HOLDS: The Commission did not err in granting unemployment benefits to Chad Kraemer. The question of whether an employee quits or is terminated is a factual determination to be made by the Commission. This Court is bound by that decision.
