Reynal Caldwell ("Husband") appeals the trial court's contempt judgment and order of commitment against him.

REVERSE

Division One Holds: The trial court's conclusion that Husband was financially capable of paying amount required by the judgment was not supported by substantial evidence. Further, the judgment of contempt and the commitment order state only conclusions, not facts, and, therefore, are facially insufficient.
