Karel R. Schubert ("Husband") appeals from the trial court's Judgment of Dissolution of Marriage ("Judgment") between him and Karen Schubert ("Wife"), *inter alia*, imputing income to Husband, awarding Wife maintenance and child support, classifying certain property as marital or non-marital, valuing and dividing the property, and awarding Wife attorney's fees.

REVERSED AND REMANDED IN PART, AFFIRMED IN PART.

Division One Holds: Because the trial court included expenses for Daughter in the maintenance calculation, the trial court erred in its calculation of Wife's reasonable needs. The trial court further erred in failing to consider interest income Wife would earn from the property awarded to her when calculating Wife's ability to provide for her reasonable needs. Accordingly, the maintenance award is reversed and remanded for the parties to present additional evidence and the court's reconsideration of the maintenance for Wife. The trial court should thereafter include the maintenance award amount on the amended Form 14 and recalculate child support. The judgment is affirmed in all other respects.
