Theresa Cochrell (Plaintiff) appeals the trial court's grant of summary judgment to Janet Schneider, Terri Coates, and Joseph Conley (collectively, "Defendants") on Plaintiff's claim of negligence. Plaintiff contends that the trial court erred in finding that Plaintiff's claim of civil conspiracy fails as a matter of law and that the doctrines of official immunity and public duty shield Defendants from liability.

Division Four Holds: In companion case of Greene v. Schneider, No. ED96553 (Mo.App.E.D. July 31, 2012), we held the trial court did not err in granting summary judgment for Defendants. Plaintiff's claim of civil conspiracy fails as a matter of law for reasons expressed in Greene opinion.
