Myra Perkins (Appellant) appeals from the trial court’s judgment entered after a bench trial denying her requests to enjoin the impeachment and removal of her as an alderman of Respondent City of Pine Lawn (Pine Lawn) and her claims for damages.

DISMISSED IN PART and AFFIRMED IN PART.

Division Three Holds: (1) Appellant’s claims that the trial court erred in entering judgment upholding her impeachment and denying her requests for injunctive relief are moot because her term as alderman expired in April 2009, making any judgment rendered by this Court merely a hypothetical opinion, and granting effectual relief legally impossible; and (2) Appellant failed to establish that Pine Lawn violated the Sunshine Act.
