OPINION SUMMARY

D.C. appeals from the trial court’s judgment of a 180-day Full Order of Protection entered pursuant to Section 455.040<sup>1</sup> and enjoining him from abusing, threatening to abuse, molesting, stalking, or disturbing the peace of J.S., from contacting J.S., or entering J.S.’s home.

APPEAL DISMISSED.

Division Three Holds: Because the Full Order of Protection expired during the pendency of this appeal, the appeal from the Full Order of Protection is moot, and, under the circumstances presented in this case, the public interest exception of Section 455.007 RSMo. Cum. Supp. 2011 is not applicable.
