PER CURIAM.

OPINION SUMMARY

N.H. ("Mother") appeals the judgment granting in part and denying in part Mother and S.C.'s ("Father") motions to modify custody of their minor child.

AFFIRMED AS MODIFIED.

Division One holds:

(1) The trial court erred in ending periods of physical custody for the Martin Luther King, Jr., President's Day, Memorial Day, and Labor Day holidays at an indeterminable time. The trial court's judgment is modified so that the periods of physical custody for those holidays end at the commencement of the academic day Tuesday.

(2) In all other respects, the judgment is affirmed under Rule 84.16(b).
