OPINION SUMMARY

Scott Henley (Movant) appeals from the motion court's Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law, and Judgment (Judgment) denying his Rule 29.15 Amended Motion to Vacate, Set Aside, or Correct Judgment and Sentence and Request for Evidentiary Hearing (PCR Motion), alleging ineffective assistance of counsel.

AFFIRMED IN PART AND REMANDED IN PART.

Division Two Holds: The trial court erred in failing to make findings of fact and conclusions of law with respect to claim 8(f) of Movant's PCR Motion. Therefore, we remand the Judgment only for the entry of findings of fact and conclusions of law with respect to that claim. In all other respects, the Judgment is affirmed pursuant to Rule 84.16(b).
