American Family Mutual Insurance Company appeals the Circuit Court of St. Louis County’s entry of summary judgment in favor of John Olsen in the amount of \$4,917,500.00 plus post-judgment interest. American Family claims that in the first place, the trial court was without jurisdiction to enter judgment due to Olsen’s failure to file timely exceptions to American Family’s answers to interrogatories, and in the second place, Global BizDimension’s insurance policy with American Family does not provide coverage for the type of damages awarded in the underlying suit.

REVERSED.

DIVISION TWO HOLDS: The trial court erred in determining that Global BizDimension’s insurance policy with American Family provided coverage for the type of damages awarded in the underlying suit because those damages did not constitute “property damage” under the terms of the policy and the law of this State. The judgment is reversed.
