Movant, Sterling Hall, appeals the denial of his Rule 24.035 motion for postconviction relief. Movant was initially delivered to the Department of Corrections for a 120-day drug treatment program in October of 2009. He did not file his Rule 24.035 motion until March 21, 2011, after he was incarcerated following his second probation revocation, and over a year after his initial delivery to the Department.
