Sedrick Wrice (“Wrice”) appeals from the sentence and judgment entered upon a jury’s verdict convicting him of burglary in the second degree.

AFFIRMED.

Division Five Holds: The trial court did not: (1) err in entering the judgment of conviction because there was sufficient evidence to support a finding of guilt beyond a reasonable doubt for burglary in the second degree; or (2) plainly err in sentencing Wrice as a prior and persistent offender because the alleged error did not result in manifest injustice or a miscarriage of justice.
