Charlene Dewey, by and through her Guardian ad Litem, Rodney Boyd, appeals the trial court's dismissal for lack of personal jurisdiction of her negligence claims against Nancy Olson.

DISMISSED.

DIVISION ONE HOLDS: The trial court's judgment only dismissed the claims against Olson, leaving claims against Thoratec Corporation, Barnes-Jewish Hospital, and Washington University. The trial court did not expressly designate in its order that "there is no just reason for delay." Rule. 74.01(b). Therefore, the trial court's order is still subject to revision and is not a final, appealable judgment. Consequently, this Court lacks authority to address the merits of the appeal.
