OPINION SUMMARY

John Osthus, Michael Page, Richard Duff, and Mary Fitzpatrick (collectively referred to as Plaintiffs), Frances Levy, Harold Boll, Beulah Boll, Deneal Schilmeister, John Hamill, Patricia Hamill, John Boyland, Beverly Boyland, Francis Basler, Steve Buschman, Mary Koken Buschman, Henry Thill, Patricia Thill, Camille Demeter, Dorothy Callier, Miles Whitener, Doris Hendrickson, Brad Bomanz, and Margaret Mathey (collectively referred to as Intervenors) appeal the trial court’s amended judgment in favor of Countrylane Woods II Homeowners Association (HOA), Eric Ruegg, Carol Weber, Michael Ritchie, Theodore Sundhausen, and Cristina Finnegan (collectively referred to as Defendants) on Plaintiffs’ and Intervenors’ petitions for declaratory judgment.

APPEAL DISMISSED.
