Paul Gittemeier (“Gittemeier”) appeals from the judgment entered upon a verdict convicting him of driving while intoxicated and trespass in the first degree.

AFFIRMED.

Division Five: Holds: The trial court did not err in entering the judgment of conviction, because there was sufficient evidence that Gittemeier drove a motor vehicle while intoxicated; and the trial court did not plainly err in granting the State’s *motion in limine* regarding Gittemeier’s expert witness.
