Robyn Siegel (Siegel) appeals from the trial court’s judgment in favor of Best Buy Builders, Inc. (Best Buy) on its Petition for Breach of Contract. On appeal, Siegel contends the trial court erred in granting judgment in favor of Best Buy for \$5,000 because Best Buy failed to meet its burden at trial of proving the rights and obligations of the parties and in demonstrating the level of damages with reasonable certainty.

AFFIRMED.

Division Two Holds: The trial court did not err in entering its judgment against Siegel and in favor of Best Buy because Best Buy presented competent and substantial evidence upon which the court could find that Siegel breached the parties’ contract and Best Buy incurred \$5,000 in damages as a result of Siegel’s breach.
