Defendant Christopher Sonnier was convicted by jury in the Circuit Court of the City of St. Louis of resisting arrest, section 575.150, R.S.Mo. (Cum. Supp. 2010), property damage in the second degree, section 569.120, R.S.Mo. (2000), and assault of a law enforcement officer in the third degree, section 565.083, R.S.Mo. (Cum. Supp. 2010).

AFFIRMED.

DIVISION FOUR HOLDS: The evidence viewed in the light most favorable to the verdict supports Sonnier's conviction for resisting arrest by fleeing, section 575.150. We decline to exercise plain error review of Sonnier's claim that he was prejudiced when members of the jury panel observed him being escorted to the courtroom in handcuffs.
