Karen Lynn Sapp, acting *pro se*, appeals from a judgment entered in the Circuit Court of Callaway County upholding the suspension of her driver's license by the Director of Revenue. On appeal, she challenges the sufficiency of the evidence to support that judgment.

**DISMISSED.**

**Division Three holds:**

- (1) Because Sapp has chosen not to file a transcript of the proceedings before the circuit court in the record on appeal in violation of Rule 81.12(a), it is impossible for this Court to review her claim that the trial court's judgment was not supported by sufficient evidence. Accordingly, her appeal must be dismissed.
