Aan Stanton appeals the decision of the Labor and Industrial Relations Commission dismissing his claim for unemployment benefits. The Commission affirmed and adopted the decision of the appeals tribunal dismissing Stanton's appeal for failure to appear.

**APPEAL DISMISSED.**

**Division Four holds:**

Stanton's sole point relied on attacks the merits of the Division deputy's decision denying him unemployment benefits. We review the Commission's decision, however, and not the Division deputy's decision. Stanton does not allege any error in the Commission's decision to dismiss his appeal for failure to appear. Because our review is confined to the points of error that the appellant raises in his points relied on, and Stanton has not raised any appealable issue for this court to review, we dismiss his appeal.
