Clayton Parsons appeals his conviction following a jury trial of the Class A misdemeanor of domestic assault in the third degree, claiming the trial court erred in refusing to permit him to call witnesses to establish an alibi defense as a sanction for his late endorsement of the witnesses when less drastic remedies would have been sufficient to prevent prejudice to the State.

We AFFIRM by unpublished opinion pursuant to Rule 30.25(b). We exercise our authority, *sua sponte*, to amend the trial court's written judgment to correct a clerical error.

We exercise the power we are afforded by Rule 30.23. The trial court's written judgment is amended to reflect that Parsons was "Found Guilty by a jury/court," instead of by guilty plea as the judgment erroneously reflects.
