Tacildayus Andrews (“Mother”) appeals the circuit court’s judgment denying her motion for leave to relocate with the two minor children. First, Mother argues that the trial court erred when it denied her motion to modify without further presentation of evidence because the trial court imposed a one day limitation on the presentation of evidence at trial. Second, Mother argues that the trial court erred when it entered its judgment giving Cort Andrews (“Father”) sole custody of two minor children because the trial court relied on evidence that was not properly received into evidence at trial.

AFFIRM.

Division One holds:

The circuit court did not error in denying Mother’s motion to modify because Mother failed to show that there was a time limitation on the presentation of evidence or make a proper offer of proof, and there was sufficient competent evidence on the record, without GAL’s report and recommendations, to support the court’s conclusion.
