**JUVENILE SEXUAL OFFENDER
REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS**

This is to inform you of the juvenile sexual offender registration requirements pursuant to Section 211.425 RSMo. Section 211.425 RSMo requires that any person who has been adjudicated delinquent for committing or attempting to commit a sex-related offense, which if committed by an adult would be considered a felony offense pursuant to chapter 566, RSMo or who has been adjudicated a juvenile delinquent in any other state or federal jurisdiction for committing or attempting to commit offenses as proscribed pursuant to chapter 566, RSMo, shall be considered a juvenile sex offender and shall be required to register as a juvenile sex offender.

Registration shall be accomplished by:

1. Juvenile Offender shall provide the following information with the juvenile office of the county where the juvenile resides;
 - a. Juvenile's Name,
 - b. Juvenile's Address,
 - c. Juvenile's Social Security Number,
 - d. Juvenile's Telephone Number,
 - e. School in which juvenile is enrolled,
 - f. Juvenile's place of employment,
 - g. Juvenile shall state the offense for which they must register, to include the date, place, and a brief description of the offense,
 - h. Juvenile shall provide the date and place of adjudication, regarding the offense, to the Juvenile Officer,
 - i. Juvenile shall provide information as to the age and gender of the victim at the time of the offense, and
2. Juvenile shall submit to being fingerprinted and photographed, copies to be kept by the juvenile office of the county where the juvenile resides.

Change of residence shall be accomplished by:

1. Juvenile's duty to register applies upon adjudication and upon the juvenile relocating to another county or relocating within the county.
2. If juvenile relocates to another address within the county where juvenile is registered, then juvenile shall notify the Juvenile Officer within ten (10) days of the new address.
3. If juvenile relocates outside the county where juvenile is registered, then juvenile shall notify the Juvenile Officer within ten (10) days of the new address and juvenile shall register with the Juvenile Officer of the new county where juvenile will reside.

Confidentiality:

1. Juvenile offices shall maintain the registration forms of those juvenile offenders in those jurisdictions who register as required by Section 211.425 RSMo.
2. The information contained on the registration forms shall be kept confidential and may be released by juvenile offices to only those persons and agencies that are authorized to receive information from juvenile court records as provided by law.

Failure to register:

1. Any juvenile who is required to register pursuant to Section 211.425 RSMo, but fails to do so or who provides false information on the registration form, is subject to disposition under the juvenile code.
2. Any person seventeen years of age or over who fails to register as required, or otherwise violates a lawful order of the court, is guilty of a class A misdemeanor, pursuant to Section 211.431 RSMo.

I have read the above stated registration requirements and understand that I shall register as a sexual offender with the county within which I reside until attaining the age of twenty-one (21) years. I understand that I shall notify the juvenile office where I am registered of any change of address, within ten (10) days of any relocation inside or outside of the county. I understand that if I relocate to another county, I shall register with the new county within ten (10) days of relocating into the new county. I understand that if I fail to register as required, I may be in violation of a valid court order and subject to further court action.
