- MEND is a 27-week program that focuses on domestic violence prevention offered at Family Counseling Center (FCC).
- The first requirement is the orientation session. Orientation sessions are held on the 2nd and 4th Wednesday of every month from 3-4 pm.
- To sign up for the MEND orientation session, you must go to FCC the same week you are ordered to attend MEND to complete your registration. The registration takes approximately 45 minutes. You must bring with you the following items:
 - A **copy of the police report** from the case in which you were ordered to participate in MEND. If you do not have a copy of the report, you can obtain one from your attorney.
 - A **paycheck stub or other proof of income**. The cost of MEND is between \$10 and \$40/session based on income. Proof of income is needed in order to calculate your fee.
- Once the orientation session is complete, you are officially enrolled and will be placed on the waiting list for the next available opening. You must call FCC once per week to check on your status. **It is your responsibility to begin class by the date assigned by the Judge.**
- Once you begin class, you will be required to attend every week. In the event of an emergency that prevents you from attending, you must call FCC prior to the class.
- FCC is located at 117 N. Garth, two blocks north of the Columbia Public Library and six blocks west of the Boone County Courthouse. The phone number is (573) 449-2581. The office is open from 8 am to 6 pm Monday through Thursday and 8 am to 12 pm on Friday.
