Applicants should be aware that interviews will be held in public during the period of October 22-23, 2014. The Commission will contact applicants after October 1, 2014, to notify them of the time and dates of the interviews.

Applicants should ask the persons listed as references to write a letter to the Chief Judge, with a copy to each Commissioner, stating their opinion of your judicial qualifications. Do not use judges as references.

Applicants should attach a brief biographical sketch to their application for publication

purposes in the event the applicant is selected as one of the three nominees. A copy of the applications of the three nominees submitted to the Governor will be made public within 72 hours of submitting the certificate of nomination; personal or confidential information will be redacted.

Individual commissioners may be willing to meet informally with applicants prior to the public interviews. Applicants should contact commissioners directly to inquire.
