POINTS RELIED ON

ARGUMENT

I. THIS COURT SHOULD REPRIMAND RESPONDENT BECAUSE
RESPONDENTS FAILURE TO RECOGNIZE THAT HIS
REPRESENTATION OF S.M. COULD BE MATERIALLY AFFECTED
AS A RESULT OF HIS EXPRESSION OF SEXUAL INTEREST IN HER
WAS NEGLIGENT.

For the purposes of this brief, Respondent adopts the argument of Informant.

Furthermore, Respondent wishes to emphasize that he recognizes the wrongness of his actions and has tried to make amends.

In addition the publishing of the informant in this cause and the resulting publicity has already caused respondent great embarrassment and loss of business, which constitutes additional punishment to his improper act.

CONCLUSION

Respondent committed professional misconduct by violating Rules 4-1.7 and 4-8.4(d) by: (a) making overt comments to S.M. as an expression of his sexual interest in her which created a concurrent conflict in violation of Rule 4-1.7 (a) (2) because his conduct presented a significant risk that his representation of S.M. would be materially limited by his personal interest in her, and (b) making sexually inappropriate comments to S.M. and offering to pay her to perform a sexual act which was conduct prejudicial to the administration of justice and violated Rule 4-8.4(d). The lack of aggravating circumstances and presence of mitigating circumstances support the imposition of discipline as described herein. Respondent respectfully requests that this Court reprimand Respondent for his conduct in accordance with Informant's recommendations.
